Principal's Report from Mrs. Paratore

MEASURE G BOND PROJECT

- Phase 1 of the Measure G Bond projects has begun with meeting with construction company.
- Mrs. Paratore provided campus map. Phase 1 (the "pink phase" on the map) will involve adding temporary portables. Work on affected classrooms to include HVAC, cabinetry and electrical.
- There was a proposal at last night's CVUSD board meeting to compact all phases so that portables don't need to be moved from school to school; Principal not sure if proposal passed.
- Phase 1 will start this summer. Portable to be delivered in May. Portables will take up blacktop space, and it will be impossible to have PE and recess at same time.
- Work on playground will involve removal of rubber mulch and replacement with rubber mats.
- Mrs. Paratore does not anticipate any teachers needing to move their classroom to a portable this school year.
- Mrs. Paratore will inform PC if portables will be arriving before Tigerthon.

OTHER

- Mrs Perris is collecting bottle caps from plastic bottles
- Mrs. Paratore working on getting rid of the extra furniture that has been sitting on playground.

Treasurer's Report by Amber Koster

- Olive Oil sale had a profit of approx. \$3500
- See's Candy Sale had a profit of approx. \$2000
- Olive Oil and See's fundraisers will be repeated in spring
- Box tops fundraiser – have received \$663 so far, which is ½ way to our goal for the year.

President's Report by Mazie Fitzgerald

- Current PC bulletin board is not meeting our needs as it is difficult to change the content under the glass plate. Cost for a new bulletin board is estimated to be \$300-400.

- There is money in the budget for a bulletin board. There was \$300 budgeted for Battle of the Books, but this event is not happening this year. There was \$800 budgeted for the summer reading program rewards, but donated books were given instead.
- Amber Koster motioned to approve purchase of a bulletin board up to \$400. Will vote at March meeting.

Fundraising Report

- Funds raised from Amazon Associates and Amazon Smile YTD is \$523.90, with another \$92.90 pending. All members are reminded to use link on PC website
- For December Olive Oil fundraiser, a new coordinator Jackie was trained. Will do another sale in spring and will advertise via website
- See's Candy Fundraiser coordinated by Jen Hansen raised \$2006. She will need PC volunteers to assist in spring. Suggestion was made to send note to superintendent and her office about fundraisers.

Upcoming Fundraisers

- Online auction to occur in mid-March.
- Coordinators are Leah Mendes, Mazie Fitzgerald and Amber Koster.
- 117 letters were sent soliciting donations.
- Discussed welcoming other donations of events, products, gift cards from Chabot community. Will do Teacher Treats. Also suggested "Spend a Day with Fred".
- Pancake Breakfast scheduled for April 29. This is the same day as CV San's Earth Day clean up at 9 am.
- Schoola is not currently accepting donations. When they do accept donations, they now require items to have an original cost of at least \$30.
- PC looking for another organization for a clothing drive, volunteers are needed.
- Thank you to Matt and Alex for making new lost and found rack for school.
- Tigerthon – a volunteer is needed to coordinate t-shirt design contest and sponsors for t-shirt. There are different levels of corporate sponsorship and price varies depending on size of ad. There are also family sponsorships.
- Will need PC volunteers for all aspects of Tigerthon.

- Book Fair Feb 21-23 in library. Need volunteers for set up, shifts after school and break down. Already have student volunteers for open house hours.
