Principal's Report

- Mrs. Paratore began by handing out a survey for the PTA National Standards for Family-School Partnerships.
- Mrs. Paratore read a few letters on behalf of the teachers who were unable to make the meeting (Mrs. Gholami/Mrs. Hohn), in support of the proposal for the purchase of chromebooks.
- Numerous teachers also spoke in support of the chromebook proposal and why it would be beneficial for all students.

Treasurer's Report

- Checking acct - \$106,171.11
- Savings acct - \$30,243.01
- Kim gave an itemized report of our incoming/outgoing funds. Before the vote on the chromebooks, Kim wanted to make clear that, though it does show a large balance in the checking account, most all of the funds are essentially counted for the following year.

Voting Results

- Computer Equipment: \$36,011.02 - **PASSED**
- Additional Funding for Science teacher: \$611 - **PASSED**
- Professional Development Workshop for Science teacher: \$1000 - **PASSED**

Incentive Programs

- Labels for Education - the program ends August 1, however we've decided to end it as of now. The program helped provide us with playground equipment/balls.
- Amazon - we've made almost \$200 more than budgeted.

- Chabot Family Dance - ticket sales were 320, filling the room to capacity; expenses were less than budgeted - it was an all around success!
